

From the Office of the County Engineer:

Resurfacing and Safety Improvements to CR 538 Franklinville / Elk Road in South Harrison and Elk Townships

RE Pierson Construction will be starting the above referenced project on Tuesday, September 8th.

The project runs on CR 538 Franklinville Road (Elk Road) between SR 77 Bridgeton Pike and SR 45 Woodstown Road in Elk and South Harrison.

The overall project includes the milling and paving of the road including base repairs, storm sewer installation and replacement, guiderail replacement, driveway aprons, curb replacement and installation, and bridge work near the intersection with Commissioners Road.

The bridge work:

- Includes the installation of a concrete bridge deck and the replacement of the parapet walls, along with other concrete repairs.
- The bridge work will require the detour of CR 538 between SR 77 and Commissioners Road, via Fislerville Road.
- The detour route will be posted with signs and message boards.
- Residents living along CR 538 within the closure will have access to their homes from SR 77 throughout the project.
- Access from Commissioners Road will not be available until the bridge work has been completed.

The overall project will last 3 months, but we anticipate that the detour will be in place until the end of October.

Notices will go out to the residents, along with the message boards being activated.
