Good afternoon everyone.

This week has been eventful to say the least and I want to share some recent information.

I received a call this morning from our Chief of Police informing me that they've had individuals in another neighboring town looking for unlocked vehicles. They did find one car unlocked with keys and stole it. This hasn't happened in our town yet, but I felt it was appropriate to share and remind us all to be diligent and keep our homes, vehicles and doors locked. Many residents have "Ring" video doorbells and if you notice something suspicious, please notify the police immediately.

We also had a house fire call. Harmony and Woolwich both arrived at the same time and quickly extinguished it before damaging the home. I have a meeting scheduled next Monday with the County and our mutual aid Fire Departments, as well as our new Fire Chief to discuss placing Harrisonville Fire Department back into service. Hopefully, they are active and responding by next week!

Yesterday one of our patrolmen, Officer Collins, was involved in a serious accident when a tractor trailer ran the intersection. Officer Collins was a former South Harrison patrolman and transitioned over to the Woolwich Police Department. I'm told he is doing well and we wish him a speedy recovery!
